Funded by a \$500,000 Choice Neighborhoods HUD Planning Grant, Envision Napier and Sudekum will create a comprehensive neighborhood revitalization plan for Napier Place, Sudekum Apartments and the surrounding area. With a commitment to enhance the cultural and economic diversity of South Nashville, this revitalization plan will provide a vehicle to replace all 821 current subsidized units, create additional workforce and market rate units and explore commercial development to ensure a holistic, financially sustainable community.



Envision Napier and Sudekum Academy Training #3 Highlights:

As MDHA moves towards creating a Neighborhood Association that reflects not only the Sudekum Apartments and Napier Place residents but includes the surrounding area, we want to make sure you are prepared and informed.

On June 9, Jocquelyn Marshall (pictured here) came and spoke to residents of Napier Place and Sudekum Apartments about the transition from a traditional public housing to a mixed-income community with an organized Neighborhood Association.

Marshall, a former resident and resident association president of C.J. Peete Public Housing in New Orleans, shared her experience moving successfully through this process. The training included a question and answer session and a team building exercise, which included other housing properties who are planning for redevelopment.







South Nashville Street Fest "Coming Together Day"

We hosted our second annual South Nashville Street Fest "Coming Together Day" on May 12 along Charles E. Davis Blvd. Hundreds of residents attended the event, which included giveaways, live entertainment, health screenings and kids activities.
