The West Roverfront Master Plan creates a vision for the development of the West Riverfront in light of these circumstances. The Master Plan transforms the West Riverfront into a civic open space that includes a promenade that serves as a flood wall, event space, lawns and plazas, peirs, a greenway and related improvements.

CDBG Disaster Recovery funds will be used for the preparation of design and construction documents for the West Riverfront to implement projects identified in the West Riverfront Master Plan.
