The draft will be submitted to HUD by November 13th and reviewed by the Homelessness Planning Council prior to submission. Our draft will not include the projects to be funded by the YHDP grant. This is the same for all of the Round 2 YHDP communities as we are all still working to determine the paths needed for youth and young adults out of homelessness.
