	NEW PROJECT OPTION: This year's Bonus project will allow for a fused project type of Permanent Supportive Housing and Transitional Housing.
	Angela Hubbard, the Community Development Director for MDHA-Nashville, facilitated a discussion with present members on the Assessment of Fair Housing. Discussion ensued among present members that included any current news surrounding local landlord and tenant interactions that could violate Fair Housing Laws.
	This discussion is in line with Nashville's Consolidated Plan. The Consolidated Plan lead is the Metropolitan Development and Housing Agency (MDHA). HUD issued materials that assist with these planning efforts.
	This is the 6 th community stakeholder meeting held on the Assessment of Fair Housing facilitated by MDHA. The conversation centers on the protected classes listed in Fair Housing Laws.
