ERIK COLE, CHAIR OF COC GOVERNANCE

ТОРІС	Erik Cole, the chair of the CoC Governance Board, presented the final CoC Governance and Community Charter recommendation from the CoC Charter Subcommittee. The language used within the charter is critical and was formed from studying several other cities' structures and charters. Additionally, the charter intentionally broadens the scope of the Continuum of Care Process. Historically, the charter focused on outlining the CoC process for the annual HUD-CoC NOFA processes for CoC-funded agencies. Charter Amendments: Page (1): Membership (after "Other interested parties") "The CoC Membership Committee will establish a membership certification process and the Collaborative Applicant will maintain all membership records." CHARTER VOTE: ALL IN FAVOR. CHARTER IS IN EFFECT AS OF 05.18.2017 with amendment.

HUD assigned the Cloudburst Group to assist the Nashville, Davidson County, TN CoC. TA officially began in October 2016. In May 2017, HUD TA hosted a 1-4 Q & Session at the Nashville Rescue Mission. This session was open to the public and all encouraged to attend.
