HMIS Facts:

FACT ONE: CONSENT TO SHARE DATA IS THE CLIENT'S DECISION!

*Programs and committees can discuss a proper consent (and should), but ultimately the client determines what is shared and what is not shared.

- 1. Nashville operates on a "partially-closed" system
 - a. Client Universal Data Elements are shared
 - i. Why: To De-duplicate client files
 - ii. Why: To allow "searchable" records
- 2. Provider Records are not open unless otherwise specified by program
 - a. Two Agencies that share Data: Safe Haven Family Shelter & Catholic Charities
 - i. Why: Program level data (things like income, non-cash, etc.)
 - ii. Why: MOU exists between the programs
- 3. CES: Not a program, but a process
 - a. Can share global data across programs
 - i. Why: to reduce the amount of paperwork clients complete
 - ii. Why: to remove barriers of communication between providers when serving clients
