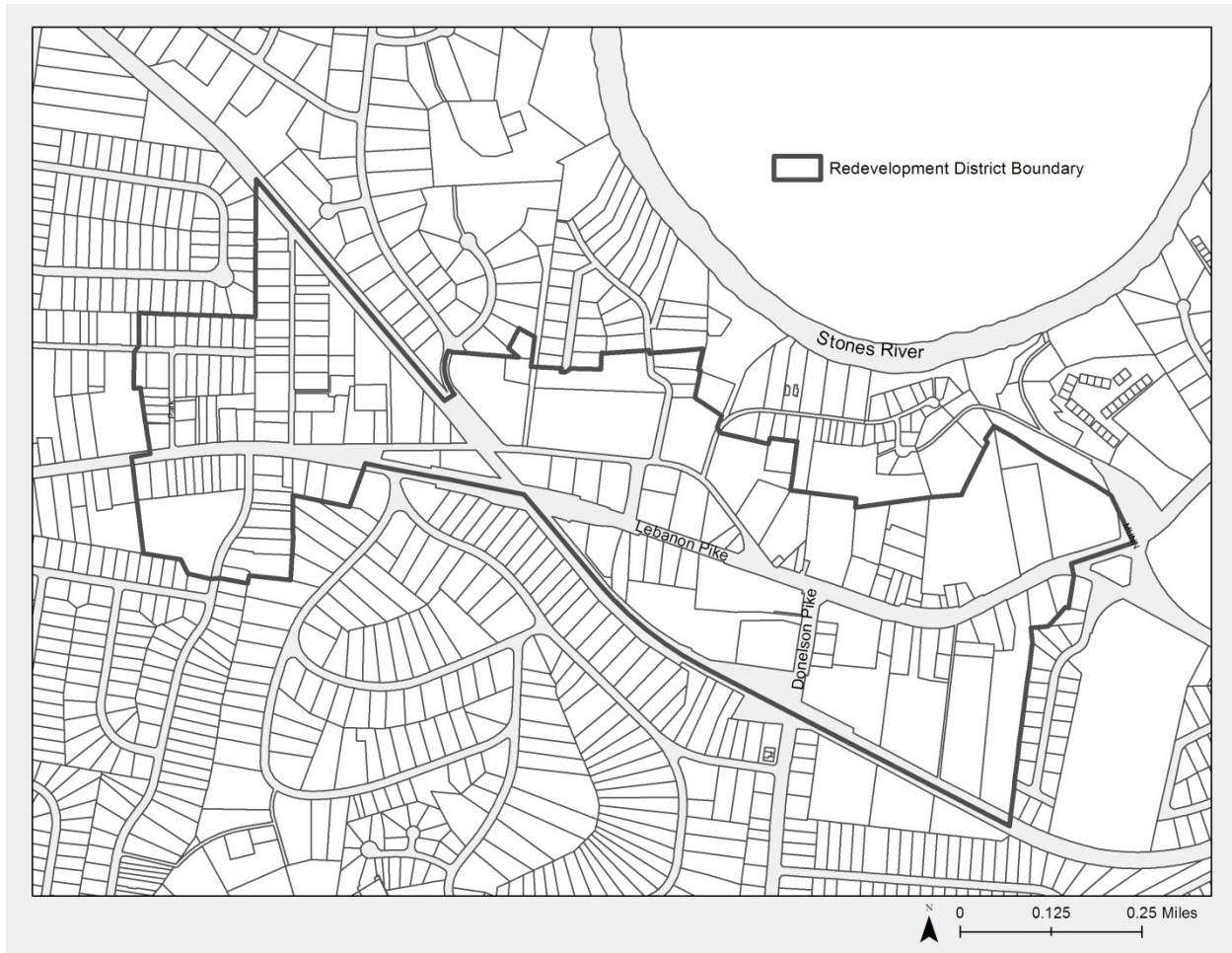


NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING



The Metropolitan Council of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County will hold a public hearing on establishing the Donelson Transit-Oriented Redevelopment District on Tuesday, April 17th, at 6:30 p.m. in the David Scobey Council Chambers in the Metropolitan Courthouse (1 Public Square, Nashville, Tennessee).

The Council shall conduct a public hearing at which any person or organization desiring to be heard regarding the proposed development plan will be afforded such an opportunity. The purpose of the hearing is to consider the creation of a Donelson Transit-Oriented Redevelopment Plan and the necessity for the inclusion of tax increment financing for the area in accordance with and in furtherance of Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA) Sections 13-20-701 through 708. The Donelson Redevelopment Area is located east of downtown Nashville and covers approximately 145 acres of land.

Copies of the plan, including a detailed map and information regarding the potential use of tax increment financing, including an estimate of the cost of the redevelopment project, the sources of revenue to finance the costs of the redevelopment project, the estimated tax increment, an estimate of the amount and final maturity relating to the tax increment indebtedness to be incurred, and an estimate of the impact of the tax increment financing provision upon the Metropolitan Government, may be viewed, as part of the proposed plan, at the offices of the Metropolitan Development and Housing Agency – Urban Development Office at 35 Peabody Street, Suite 301, Nashville, Tennessee 37210 (615-252-8504).
