- Perform installation, maintenance and repair of the electrical, plumbing, gas, sewer and drainage systems in accordance with applicable state and federal regulations;
- Perform repair and maintenance on heating and air conditioning systems;
- Perform repair and maintenance of building structural system and perform carpentry work on building interior finishes;
- Become knowledgeable and perform duties specified in the MDHA Gas Emergency Plan in accordance with DOT and TRA regulations;
- Knowledgeable of pesticide operation and procedures with the ability to treat housing and building for pest, and vermin;
- Prepare gas systems for the annual inspections by the Tennessee Regulatory Authority;
- Answer work order calls for plumbing, gas, sewage, AC, heating, sewer and drainage repair;
- Inspects housing units for the repair and maintenance of electrical, carpentry, plumbing, HVAC, gas, sewer and drainage lines for damage, leaks and repairs;
- Purchase supplies and equipment on an as needed basis;
- Document and keep accurate records of work performed in apartments and buildings;
- Complies with safety rules and regulations
