REQUIRED EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

High school education and general knowledge of construction with at least 1 year experience. Candidates with accreditation earned in foreign institutes are encouraged to apply

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES:

- Assist skilled workers such as carpenters, plumbers, HVAC technicians, painters and concrete finishers in the building, maintenance and repair of building systems, structures and utilities;
- Assist in the demolition of structures and salvage useful materials;
- Safe use of hand and power tools such as saws, drills and planes;
- Mop, brush, or spread paints, cleaning solutions or other camp compounds over surfaces to clean them or to provide protection;
- Perform inspections, mix and apply pesticides in buildings in compliance with policy and procedures;
- Assist in the repairs and maintenance of building fixtures, furniture, electrical and plumbing systems;
- Assist in the repairs and maintenance of plumbing systems including water heaters, toilets, sinks, water fountains, potable and drainage pipes, sewage, water lines and backflow;
- Assist in the repairs and preventative maintenance on HVAC and other environmental systems;
- Assist in the repairs of electrical systems including switches, fixtures, panels and related systems;
- Replaces or installs doors, locks, windows, and related hardware;
- Assist in the Installation and repairs of building drywall, cabinetry, build ramps, install railing and related items;
- Assist in the process to ensure all building safety systems and utilities are operational.
