Envision Edgehill Apartments

MDHA has begun the master planning process to redevelop Edgehill Apartments into a mixed-income community. One of the goals is to maintain a one-for-one replacement of the existing 380 subsidized units at Edgehill Apartments, while adding workforce and market rate rental units. Planning for Envision Edgehill Apartments is an 18-month long process, which will be resident-led and community supported. A comprehensive needs assessment will be completed early in the planning process to identify gaps and needs in services such as social services, healthcare, employment/job training, capacity building, crime, transportation and education. The final transformation plan will become the guiding document to revitalize Edgehill Apartments.



How You Can Get Involved Join the Community Advisory Group (CAG)

The **mission of the CAG** is to aid in the planning and redevelopment process of transforming the existing Edgehill Apartments community.

The vision of the CAG is to serve as a collaborative effort led by MDHA's new Recapitalization Team along with Salama Urban Ministries. Our goal is to move forward in our planning phase of developing a successful neighborhood transformation plan and build the support necessary for that plan to be successfully implemented.

The **CAG** is the **CORE GROUP** that serves as the information hub of the planning process for the redevelopment of Edgehill Apartments.

The CAG is made up of the following: residents of both public housing properties, local church leaders, business owners, community organizations, local developers and community members.

Each CAG member will join a work group they feel best fits their specific area of concern and expertise. They will serve on the work group of their choice throughout the 18 month planning process.

There are three core areas of focus: People, Housing and Neighborhood, which lines up with our three work groups: The People Work Group, Housing Work Group and Neighborhood Work Group.

Each of our CAG members commitment to work on a specific "Work Group" is vital to an effective and successful planning process and a completed Transformational Plan at the end of the 18 month period.

Salama Urban Ministries will be in charge of hiring residents of Edgehill Apartments and Gernert Studio Apartments. The hiring process will start in September. Applications may be obtained at Salama Urban Ministries located at 1205 8th Ave. S, Nashville, TN 37203.

More on the survey:

Salama Urban Ministries and the survey proctors will conduct a survey of all households within the Edgehill Apartments and Gernert Studio Apartments community and the surrounding area, which includes businesses, organizations and other residential areas.

The purpose of the survey is to identify the needs of those who live in the community. We are going to ask questions about your housing, neighborhood, transportation, employment and schools. We will use your responses to create a plan for a realistic, viable, mixed-income and sustainable neighborhood with access to well-functioning services, high quality public schools and education programs, public assets, public transportation and improved access to jobs. Responses to the survey are strictly confidential and will not be shared with anyone.

The survey schedule will begin Oct. 16th and end Nov. 18th.
