Disaster Damage:

New Construction (Replacement Housing) - SIngle-Family Homes

A significant portion of Nashville's workforce housing stock was impacted by the flood, and many homes were not replaced or residents chose to relocate outside of areas prone to flooding. To replenish the housing stock, offer more housing choices, and encourage revitalization of a targeted corridor as contemplated in the Long Term Recovery Plan, CDBG Disaster Recovery Funds will provide assistance for the development of single-family homes. MDHA has prepared four additional amendments to the Action Plan for Disaster Recovery – technical Amendment Two

MDHA has prepared four additional amendments to the Action Plan for Disaster Recovery – technical Amendment Two (2011), substantial Amendment Three (2013) approved and authorized by RS2013-771, substantial Amendment Four (2014) approved and authorized by RS2014-1193 and substantial Amendment Five (2017) approved and authorized by RS-2018-1091- to provide further clarification of the proposed activities described in Amendment One and to reallocate funds from activities that have been canceled or closed to other existing activities.

Recovery Needs:

As activities described in the Action Plan, as amended, are completed, remaining funds need to be reprogrammed to a new activity under the existing housing project to fully utilize these funds. MDHA has prepared Amendment Six to the Action Plan for Disaster Recovery to reallocate funds administered by The Housing Fund totaling \$1,043,148.50 from Homeowner and Rental Rehab Loan and Grant programs in the original housing project to be used for new construction of affordable single family housing.

Public Comment:

The Metropolitan Government and MDHA support and encourage citizen participation in the development of the Disaster Recovery Action Plan and related amendments. Many of the concerns expressed by citizens participating in the long-term recovery planning process have been incorporated into this Plan, as amended. The Citizen Participation Process complies with the requirements published in the Notice of allocations, waivers, and alternative requirements [Federal Register, Volume 75, Number 217, Docket Number FR-5452-N-01, effective November 15, 2010].

The Public Notice advertising the availability of the draft Plan and opportunities for public comment was published in The Tennessean, posted on MDHA's website and social media. The public comment period began on April 20, 2020 and ended on April 30, 2020. No comments were recieved. Following the conclusion of the public comment period, Amendment Six was approved by the Metropolitan Council.

Overall Progress Narrative:

During this quarter, program income receipts were created, and funds were drawn for the PI expenses for The Housing Fund (THF). MDHA staff has been informed that these receipts and draws may not need to be tracked in DRGR. We are working with Field Office staff to resolve this issue before grant closeout and await more guidance on how to proceed. Next quarter, staff will continue to update information in DRGR, including addresses for activities that have not been reported. The grant currently has one open activity with funds to draw, Sherwood Commons, developed by Habitat for Humanity of Greater Nashville. Habitat is currently working through Metro approvals to receive the final U&Os for each unit, which they expect to receive in the next quarter. Homeowners were allowed to close on the sale of their homes with temporary use and occupancy permits and are occupying the units. Once the remaining funds are drawn from the line of credit for the Habitat project, staff will begin working on closing out the grant. During the next quarter, MDHA staff will schedule a monitoring visit for THF on their open activities and overall management

During the next quarter, MDHA staff will schedule a monitoring visit for THF on their open activities and overall management of the CDBG-DR funds. The results of this visit will be reported in next quarter's QPR. A target date of December 31, 2023, has been set to close the grant.

All 26 homes at Sherwood Commons have been sold to their respective owners and are being lived in. The remaining funds to be drawn on the grant are pending the final certificates of occupancy, which Habitat expects to receive in early August. The work remaining to be completed is not related to the homes themselves but to common elements such as sidewalks. Specifically, Habitat has been asked to replace eight sidewalk slabs. A few final sign-offs are also still pending from Metro officials which could alter the timeline if additional requirements are imposed.

In addition, The Housing Fund has reached out to Habitat to inform them that there might be approximately \$15,000 of funding still available if Habitat could use it. They have confirmed that yes, they could, and are awaiting formal, signed documentation and a specific dollar amount that is available.

Habitat plans to make one final draw on the grant or around the middle of August, which assumes all final approvals, permanent COs, and documentation on the extra funding potentially available.
